

The above agenda was thoroughly discussed and the recommendations of the committee constituted by Hon'ble Vice-chancellor for awarding the gold medals to the students of UG, Master's and Ph.D. programmes were approved after considering and incorporating some changes /modifications in the guide lines approved in the 267 Academic Council meeting dated 17.6.2019 in agenda no. 267:1541 as detailed below-

- विश्वविद्यालय के अन्तर्गत संचालित प्रत्येक महाविद्यालय के स्नातक पाठ्यक्रम में प्रथम, द्वितीय एवं तृतीय स्थान प्राप्त कर उपाधि पाने वाले छात्र-छात्राओं को क्रमशः कुलाधिपति, कुलपति एवं विश्वविद्यालय स्वर्ण पदक प्रदान किये जायेंगे।
- स्नातक स्तर पर एक डिग्री प्रोग्राम में सभी महाविद्यालयों को मिलाकर एक कुलाधिपति स्वर्ण पदक एवं उसी डिग्री पाठ्यक्रम के लिए प्रत्येक महाविद्यालय स्तर पर एक-एक कुलपति स्वर्ण पदक एवं एक-एक विश्वविद्यालय स्वर्ण पदक प्रदान किये जायेंगे।



- एक महाविद्यालय में संचालित एक या एक से अधिक स्नातक पाठ्यक्रमों में सामूहिक रूप से प्रथम, द्वितीय एवं तृतीय स्थान प्राप्त करने वाले उपाधि प्राप्तकर्ताओं को कमशः कुलाधिपति, कुलपति एवं विश्वविद्यालय स्वर्णपदक का एक सेट ही प्रदान किया जायेगा। इस प्रकार महामाया कृषि अभियांत्रिकी एवं अभियंत्रण महाविद्यालय, अम्बेडकरनगर में बी०टेक कृषि अभियांत्रिकी, अभियंत्रण अभियांत्रिकी एवं कम्प्यूटर साइंस एवं अभियांत्रिकी के तीन स्नातक उपाधियों को एक समूह में सम्मिलित करते हुए प्रथम, द्वितीय एवं तृतीय स्थान प्राप्त करने वाले उपाधि प्राप्तकर्ताओं को तीन के बजाय एक ही सेट स्वर्ण पदक प्रदान किये जायेगे क्योंकि इस महाविद्यालय के सभी स्नातक पाठ्यक्रमों में कुल छात्र-छात्राओं की संख्या एक महाविद्यालय के समान ही है।
- विश्वविद्यालय के प्रत्येक महाविद्यालय में विभिन्न विषयों में संचालित परास्नातक पाठ्यक्रमों में प्रत्येक विषय में अधिकतम अंक प्राप्त करने वाले छात्र-छात्राओं को कुलपति स्वर्ण पदक प्रदान करने की परम्परा को समाप्त करना उचित होगा क्योंकि एक विषय में अध्ययनरत 2 से लेकर 10-15 उपाधि प्राप्तकर्ताओं में एक कुलपति स्वर्ण पदक प्रदान करना वर्तमान परिवेश में गरिमा के अनुरूप नहीं प्रतीत होता है। विश्वविद्यालय के अन्तर्गत संचालित सभी महाविद्यालयों के परास्नातक पाठ्यक्रमों के सभी विषयों/विभागों को एक समूह में सम्मिलित करते हुए विश्वविद्यालय स्तर पर प्रथम स्थान प्राप्त करने वाले उपाधि प्राप्तकर्ता को एक कुलाधिपति स्वर्ण पदक प्रदान किया जायेगा। जबकि प्रत्येक महाविद्यालय के परास्नातक पाठ्यक्रम के सभी विषयों में सामूहिक रूप से प्रथम स्थान प्राप्त करने वाले उपाधि प्राप्तकर्ता को एक कुलपति स्वर्ण पदक दिया जायेगा।
- समिति के सदस्यों ने वीक्षोपरान्त यह सुझाव दिया कि कम से कम 25 छात्र-छात्राओं की स्पर्धा को समाप्त किया जाना चाहिए अन्यथा कई महाविद्यालयों के छात्र-छात्रायें स्वर्ण पदक से वंचित रह जायेंगे/जायेंगी। किसी भी महाविद्यालय के परास्नातक पाठ्यक्रम में उपाधि प्राप्तकर्ताओं को स्वर्ण पदक प्रदान करने की अर्हता हेतु उस पाठ्यक्रम में कम से कम 05 छात्र-छात्राओं की स्पर्धा अवश्य होनी चाहिए।
- स्नातक एवं परास्नातक पाठ्यक्रमों में कुलपति, कुलपति एवं विश्वविद्यालय स्वर्ण पदकों को प्राप्त करने के लिए न्यूनतम ओवरआल ग्रेड प्वाइंट एवरेज (OGPA) की अर्हता कमशः 8.5, 8.0 एवं 7.5 होनी चाहिए तथा उपाधि प्राप्तकर्ता के अध्ययनकाल में यदि कभी भी शैक्षणिक (Academic) या आचरण (Conduct) परीक्षा (Probation) लगा हो तो उसकी स्वर्ण पदक प्राप्त करने की अर्हता से वंचित कर दिया जायेगा।
- पी-एच०डी० पाठ्यक्रम में स्वर्ण पदक प्रदान करने हेतु यह निर्णय हुआ कि इस सन्दर्भ में पी-एच०डी० पाठ्यक्रम के दौरान पढे गये कोर्सों के अंक एवं पी-एच०डी० शोध ग्रन्थ के शोध कार्य से प्रकाशित अधिकतम दो शोध पत्रों की नास रेटिंग (NAAS Rating) को आधार मानते हुए वरीयता कम तय किया जायेगा एवं सभी महाविद्यालयों में सामूहिक रूप से प्रथम, द्वितीय एवं तृतीय स्थान प्राप्त करने वाले उपाधि प्राप्त कर्ताओं को मात्र एक सेट कुलाधिपति, कुलपति एवं विश्वविद्यालय स्वर्ण पदक प्रदान किया जायेगा। शोधग्रन्थ जमा करते समय विद्यार्थी द्वारा प्रकाशित (Published)/स्वीकृत (Accepted) दो शोध पत्रों के NAAS Rating के औसत (अधिकतम 10.00 अंक) को OGPA में जोड दिया जायेगा और दोनों के योग



1. The final examinations of all classes/years of under-graduate, postgraduate and Ph.D. courses except B.V.Sc. & A.H. offered in the IInd Semester 2019-20 still not held will be conducted using on-line systems immediately after completion of on-going mid-term and practical examinations.

2. The on-line examinations will be conducted by using Google classroom, WhatsApp and email system.
3. The objective question papers of on-line final examination of U.G. and P.G. courses will be of the similar pattern as approved by the Academic Council earlier for the on-line final examination of final year undergraduate & postgraduate students.
4. Three sets of objective type question papers of final examination prepared by the course instructor(s), except for Ph.D. courses, will be submitted to the Dean of the College in advance. The Dean will provide one of the three sets of the question papers 30.0 minutes before the scheduled start of the on-line examination, which also will be held under the supervision of the Dean or an observer deputed by him. The answer sheet of students will be downloaded and printed by the instructors for submission to the Dean of the college after completion of the evaluation. The question papers of Ph.D. courses will be prepared and operated by the concerned instructor(s) themselves.
5. The question paper for on-line mid-term and final examinations of Ph.D. courses will have eighty (80) objective questions comprising 20 questions each of four types or sections, namely, (A) Multiple Choice, (B) Fill in the blanks, (C) True or False and (D) Matching type. The student can attempt all the questions. However, maximum eighteen (18) correct questions from section A and B each and maximum 17 correct questions from section C and D each will be considered for marking to complete a total of seventy questions in 75.0 minutes (1.15 hour). Each objective question will be of 0.5 (1/2) mark so that the 70 questions considered will complete 35.0 maximum marks allotted for mid-term and final examinations for courses having theory as well as practical.
6. The courses having only theory in Ph.D. courses, the mid-term and final examinations will be of 45 marks each. The on-line examination paper will be of 100 objective questions comprising of 25 questions each of four types or sections, namely, (A) Multiple Choice, (B) Fill in the blanks, (C) True or False and (D) Matching type. Student can attempt all the questions. However, maximum twenty three (23) correct questions from section A and B each and maximum 22 correct questions from section C and D each will be considered for marking to complete a total of ninety questions in 90.0 minutes (1.30 hour). Each objective question will be of 0.5 (1/2) mark so that the 90 questions considered will complete 45.0 maximum marks allotted for mid-term and final examination for courses having only theory.
7. In case of Ph.D. courses having only practical without any theory, the practical examination will be conducted by allotting 50 marks for on-line *viva-voice* and 50 marks for on-line short answer questions/assignment to make a total of 100 marks allotted for practical examination of courses comprising only practical.
8. Depending upon the situation (poor internet etc.) instructor may accept the late submission of the answer sheets after submission of proper

justification by him through Dean of the College and Registrar and subsequent approval of the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor.

9. प्रश्न दिये जायेंगे। जिसमें कि (A) Multiple choice (B) Fill in the blanks (C) True or False (D) Matching type के 20-20 प्रश्न दिये जायेंगे। छात्रों को सभी प्रश्न करना होगा। जबकि सभी भागों (A, B, C and D) से वेस्ट 15 प्रश्नों का मूल्यांकन होगा। और इसके लिए कुल समय 75 मिनट (1 घंटा 15 मिनट) दिया जायेगा। प्रत्येक प्रश्न 0.5 का मार्क्स होगा। जिसमें कि 60 प्रश्न कुल 30 मार्क्स को पूरा करलें जो कि आन्तरिक थ्योरी परीक्षा के लिए आवंटित है। जिस कोर्स में केवल थ्योरी है और 50 मार्क्स की परीक्षा होनी है उसके लिए कुल 120 प्रश्न दिये जायेंगे जिसमें कि (A) Multiple choice (B) Fill in the blanks (C) True or False (D) Matching type के 30-30 प्रश्न होंगे। छात्र सभी 120 प्रश्न का उत्तर दे सकते हैं। जबकि प्रत्येक भाग से (A, B, C and D) से वेस्ट 25 प्रश्नों का मूल्यांकन होगा। इस तरह कुल 100 प्रश्न का मूल्यांकन होगा। प्रत्येक प्रश्न के लिए 0.5 मार्क्स दिये जायेंगे। जिसमें कि 100 प्रश्न से कुल 50 मार्क्स मिल पाये। और इसके लिए 120 मिनट (2 घंटा) का समय दिया जायेगा। पुराने पाठ्यक्रम के छात्रों का प्रयोगात्मक परीक्षा थ्योरी के बाद 17/08/2020 से एक सप्ताह के अन्दर कोर्स अनुदेशक के द्वारा सम्पादित करवाये जायेंगे। आन्तरिक प्रयोगात्मक परीक्षा का निर्धारित 20 मार्क्स में 10 मार्क्स का वाइबा होगा और 10 मार्क्स का आनलाइन लघु प्रश्न-उत्तर/एसाइनमेन्ट देकर प्रयोगात्मक परीक्षा सम्पादित किये जायेंगे। ऐसे विषय जिसमें कि सिर्फ प्रयोगात्मक ही है उसमें प्रयोगात्मक परीक्षा के लिए कुल 50 मार्क्स निर्धारित है। अतः इन विषयों में 25 मार्क्स का आनलाइन वाइवोसी एवं 25 मार्क्स का लघु प्रश्न-उत्तर/एसाइनमेन्ट से आन्तरिक प्रयोगात्मक परीक्षा सम्पादित करवायी जायेगी।

**279:1618: To consider and approve the proposal of Dean, C.V.Sc. & A.H. regarding conduct of comprehensive examination of rotational internship for final year B.V.Sc. & A.H. students following the guidelines and rules formulated in the faculty meeting held on 27.7.2020.**

The agenda was approved with following decisions :

1. Evaluation of internship students will be in two parts a) written comprehensive examination and b) viva-voce examination.
2. Written comprehensive examination will be of 50 marks and comprises only objective types of question.
3. All the 33 interns will participate in this online written comprehensive examination irrespective of delay in their completion of programme.
4. Viva-voce of student will be conducted on completion of internship duration.
5. Written examination will be conducted only through the online mode preferably by Google classroom/ Whats App.
6. Written comprehensive examination will be conducted as per University guidelines.
7. The question paper for online comprehensive examination will have 120 objective types of questions comprising 30 questions each of four types sections, namely, (A) Fill in the blanks, (B) True or False (C) Multiple Choice and (D) Matching types. The student can attempt all the questions. However, best 25 questions from each section A, B, C,

D will be considered for marking to complete a total of 100 questions in 120.0 minutes (2.00 hours). Each objective question will be of 0.5 (1/2) mark so that the 100 questions considered will complete 50.00 maximum marks.

8. After written comprehensive examination and completion of duration of internship period students will appear in on-line viva-voce examination.

279:1619: To consider and approve the proposal of Dean, C.V.Sc. & A.H. regarding the conduct of practical and Annual Board Examination of I<sup>st</sup>, II<sup>nd</sup>, III<sup>rd</sup> & IV<sup>th</sup> year students of B.V.Sc. & A.H. as per MSVE as well as recommendations of Board of Faculty of C.V.Sc. & A.H.

The agenda was approved with following decisions :

1. The conduction of Annual board examination (external) is not possible at this moment, it is decided to allow the students provisional registration in the next class (on or after 1<sup>st</sup> September) subjected to the condition that the students will appear for external annual board examination and when university reopens and they will be finally allowed accordingly.
2. The Annual Board (MSVE-2016)/ Internal Practical examination will be conducted through online mode after 17<sup>th</sup> August 2020.
3. Annual board practical examination of students studying in new course syllabi of VCI (MSVE-2016), the practical examination paper of 60 marks will be distributed as Viva-voce 20 marks, Quiz 20marks, Assignment 10 marks and Records 10 marks, while, the subject of only practical examination paper of 50 marks will be distributed as Viva-voce 15 marks, Quiz 15 marks, Assignment 10 marks and Record 10 marks.
